Dear Matt:

On November 21, 2019 Spring Creek Mine (SCM) submitted a request to the Department to transfer Surface Mine Permit (SMP) C1979012 from Spring Creek Coal LLC to Navajo Transitional Energy Company, LLC (NTEC). This request was sent to the Department outside of the ePermit system since transfers are dependent on some rules not used within the ePermit system.

On January 2, 2020, SCM received comments back from MDEQ on the initial submittal. Since then, the Coal Program has determined that it makes more sense to submit the transfer request as a minor revision to the permit and take care of the documents that are not a part of the permit as attachments to our submittal letter. As such, there will be attachments to this, and possibly future response letters to SCM's permit transfer application that SCM respectfully requests be kept confidential. These will be clearly labeled in the naming convention and within the document as CONFIDENTIAL.

MR262 has been submitted in the ePermit system. The section reflecting the most changes is the "Admin" section with Legal Right to Enter and assignment of Agreements being addressed. It is understood that throughout the entire permit the Department would prefer that references to "Spring Creek Coal Company", "SCCC", "Spring Creek Coal, LLC", and "SCC" be changed to generic "the operator", "Spring Creek Mine", or "SCM". That is a goal that we will work toward and possibly be able to make progress in that direction with further comment/response rounds with this revision. However, our first focus is to resolve all content responses specific to the permit transfer. In order to provide "blanket" information broadly across the permit, the compliance document stored under "Other Permit Information"/"Format and Supplemental Information" entitled 302 ComplyInfo MR262 20200818.doc explains the different mine name references and Spring Creek Mine's intent to eventually clean all references up.

Responses to January 2, 2020 comments are as follows:

ARM 17.24.418:

- 1. Please provide updated coal leases (BLM, DNRC, and Private) verifying NTEC's right to mine.
 - SCM has not yet obtained the transfer of Federal agreements. These transfers are anticipated in 2020, but SCM sees value in processing as many of the permit transfer comments as possible right away in order to simply finalizing the permit transfer application when the eventual lease transfers and bonding are in place. Listed below these responses under "Affected Permit Materials" are all of the updated documents in regard to Right to Mine and Legal Right to Enter. Each of these updated documents contains bookmarks for the assignment to NTEC (or a placeholder for eventual assignment in regard to Federal agreements).
- 2. Please provide signing authority for Heath Hill as Executive Vice President.

 The signing authority for Heath Hill is attached to this letter since there is not a section for this in ePermit.
- 3. Please submit the complete assignment form and provide proof of agency.

 The second page was inadvertently left off in the first submittal. Attached to this letter is the complete document.
- 4. Under attachment 06_AssignmentAssumptions Page 3 of 5 has Prospecting Permit N2012009 listed. This is incorrect, please remove. Also, keep in mind that the Prospecting Permit must be transferred as a separate application. N2012009 and X2011336 have been removed from this listing. The revised file is attached to this letter and has been renamed to: 20200102 MDEQComment4 N2012009-X2011336
- 5. Under attachment 07_APA Lease Assignment, the leases do not cover all the legal description. This needs to be addressed.
 As in comment #1 above: Listed below these responses under "Affected Permit Materials" are all of the updated documents in regard to Right to Mine and Legal Right to Enter. Each of these updated documents contain bookmarks for the assignment to NTEC (or a placeholder for eventual assignment in regard to Federal agreements).
- 6. Please submit a complete and fully-effective waiver of the Navajo Transitional Energy Company's (NTEC) sovereign immunity which has been accepted and approved by the State of Montana.
 - A durable Limited Waiver of Sovereign Immunity which was agreed upon between the State of Montana and NTEC on March 12th, 2020. It is assumed that this agreement is on file with MDEQ's legal department.

 - 303_AddmW_RestatedAccessAgmts_DCC was renamed to 303_Addm-o-3_DCC_SCM_Agreements_MR262_20200818 and now contains several SCM-DCC agreements, allowing for removal of several, now redundant documents
 - The agreement in Addendum_303E_HaulroadEasement is now wholly included with other DCC-SCM agreements in 303_Addm-o-3_DCC_SCM_Agreements_MR262_20200818 Addendum_303E_HaulroadEasement has now been removed from the permit.
 - Addendum_303F_BLM_CommercialUseLease was superseded by Addendum_303W_LandLease_74913_20200210_TR1MR232 which is now renamed to 303_Addm-o-17_BLM_LUL74913_MR262_20200818, Addendum_303F_BLM_CommercialUseLease has now been removed from the permit.
 - Addendum_303G_RRspurPowerEase_MT was renamed to 303_Addm-o-4_MT_RR-PowerEasement_MR262_20200818
 - Addendum_303H_RRspurPowerEase_DCC is wholly contained within what is now 303_Addm-o-3_DCC_SCM_Agreements_MR262_20200818,
 Addendum 303H RRspurPowerEase DCC has been removed from the permit
 - Addendum_303I_RRspurROW_BLM was renamed to 303_Addm-o-5_BLM_RR-ROW_MR262_20200818.
 This Addendum will be updated upon Federal transfers to NTEC.
 - Addendum_303J_AccessRdEase_BLM was renamed to 303_Addm-o-6_BLM_AccessRdEasement_MR262_20200818
 This Addendum will be updated upon Federal transfers to NTEC.

- Addendum_303K_SF_FloodCtrlEase_CCC was removed from the permit because the Navajo Transitional Energy Company, LLC (NTEC) acquired all legal estate previously held by Arrowhead I LLC, successor to Consolidation Coal Company and lands adjacent to and within the permit area.
- Addendum_303L_LeaseCoal_Carbone_ST was renamed to 303_Addm-o-7_MT-LeaseCoal_Carbone_MR262_20200818
 Information on Federal Coal Lease MTM 88405 which had been duplicated in this addendum has now been removed and placed in Addendum 303U where all other information to MTM 88405 has been housed.
- Addendum_303M_LeaseSurface_Resource was superseded by subsequent transactions ultimately ending with NTEC holding deeds to all pertinent lands now within the SCM permit as evidenced in 303_Addm-o-1_NTEC_SurfaceOwnership_MR262_20200818, as such Addendum 303M_LeaseSurface_Resource has been removed from the permit
- Addendum_303N_AccessAgmt_SCC_DCC was renamed to 303_Addm-o-8_DCC_DraglineCorridor_MR262_20200818
- Addendum_303O_WaiverIndmn_DNRC was renamed to 303_Addm-o-9_DNRC_StockpileWaiver_MR262_20200818
- Addendum_303P_LeaseGrazeCoal_MT_20110426_APP183 was updated with transfer information, extraneous information removed, and renamed to 303_Addm-o-10_MT_LeaseCoal_C-1088-15_MR262_20200818
- Addendum_303Q_LandUsePermit_20110426_APP183 was updated with transfer information and renamed to 303_Addm-o-11_BLM_LUP96659_MR262_20200818
 This Addendum will be updated upon Federal transfers to NTEC.

 This Addendum will be updated upon Federal Lease transfers to NTEC.
- Addendum_303X_Arrowhead_20200210_TR1MR232 is no longer needed since the change in ownership. NTEC now owns the former "Arrowhead" and the "Spring Creek Coal Company" properties so no notice is required to "Arrowhead" for disturbance being within 100 feet of the property boundary any longer. As such, Addendum_303X_Arrowhead_20200210_TR1MR232 is removed from the permit.
- Addendum_303Y_DeckerOver_20200210_TR1MR232 is wholly contained within what is now 303_Addm-o-3_DCC_SCM_Agreements_MR262_20200818. As such, 303_AddmY_DCC_OverstripAgreement_20200210_TR1MR232 is removed from the permit.

This cover letter is saved in the "Reports/Correspondence" section. There is no change to the TOC or Drawing Index with this revision.
