This document represents an overview of the Western States Contracting Alliance's Breast Pumps and Related Accessories contract. This document is not intended to replace or append the contract, rather to provide an overview and summary of the agreement.

1.0 BACKGROUND

The State of Montana is a member of the Western States Contracting Alliance (WSCA), which establishes the means by which participating states may join together in cooperative multi-state contracting in order to achieve cost-effective and efficient acquisition of quality products and services. This contract is a result of a cooperative procurement conducted by the State of Washington on behalf of WSCA.

1.1 PURPOSE

The purpose of this non-exclusive Term Contract is to provide State agencies and all registered cooperative purchasing organizations with an expedited means of obtaining breast pumps and related accessories. This contract is awarded to three vendors: Ameda, Inc., Hygeia II Medical Group, Inc., and Medela, Inc.

1.2 NON-EXCLUSIVE CONTRACT

The intent of this contract is to provide state agencies with an expedited means of procuring supplies and/or services. This contract is for the convenience of state agencies and is considered by the State Procurement Bureau to be a "Non-exclusive" use contract. Therefore, agencies may obtain this product/service from sources other than the contract holder(s) as long as they comply with Title 18, MCA, and their delegation agreement.
