### 1.0 BACKGROUND

The State of Montana is a member of the WSCA/NASPO, which establishes the means by which participating states may join together in cooperative multi-state contracting in order to achieve cost-effective and efficient acquisition of quality products and services. This contract is a result of cooperative procurement conducted by the State of Washington on behalf of WSCA/NASPO.

### 2.0 PURPOSE

The purpose of this contract is provide state agencies and all registered cooperative purchasing organizations with an expedited means of obtaining Police Radar, Lidar, Parts, and Equipment.

### 3.0 NON-EXCLUSIVE CONTRACT

The intent of this contract is to provide state agencies with an expedited means of procuring supplies and/or services. This contract is for the convenience of state agencies and is considered by the State Procurement Bureau to be a "Non-exclusive" use contract. Therefore, agencies may obtain this product/service from sources other than the contract holder(s) as long as they comply with Title 18, MCA, and their delegation agreement. 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### **5.0 ORDERING PROCEDURE**

### **7.0 CONTRACT RENEWAL**

This contract may, upon mutual agreement between the parties and according to the terms of the existing contract, be renewed in one-year intervals, or any interval that is advantageous to the State. This contract, including any renewals, may not exceed a total of five years.
