Breast Pumps and Related Accessories (WSCA/WIC)

This document represents an overview of the Western States Contracting Alliance's Breast Pumps and Related Accessories contract. This document is not intended to replace or append the contract, rather to provide an overview and summary of the agreement.

1.0 BACKGROUND

The State of Montana is a member of the Western States Contracting Alliance (WSCA), which establishes the means by which participating states may join together in cooperative multi-state contracting in order to achieve cost-effective and efficient acquisition of quality products and services. This contract is a result of a cooperative procurement conducted by the State of Washington on behalf of WSCA.

1.1 PURPOSE

The purpose of this non-exclusive Term Contract is to provide State agencies and all registered cooperative purchasing organizations with an expedited means of obtaining breast pumps and related accessories. This contract is awarded to three vendors: Ameda, Inc., Hygeia II Medical Group, Inc., and Medela, Inc.

1.2 NON-EXCLUSIVE CONTRACT

The intent of this contract is to provide state agencies with an expedited means of procuring supplies and/or services. This contract is for the convenience of state agencies and is considered by the State Procurement Bureau to be a "Non-exclusive" use contract. Therefore, agencies may obtain this product/service from sources other than the contract holder(s) as long as they comply with Title 18, MCA, and their delegation agreement.

1. Scope: This addendum covers the WSCA Breast Pumps Contract lead by the State of Washington, for members of WSCA or NASPO, for use by Participating Entity's programs, including Women, Infants & Children Programs office.
2. Participation: Use of specific WSCA or NASPO cooperative contracts by other agencies, political subdivisions and other entities (including cooperatives) authorized by an individual state's statutes to use state contracts are subject to the approval of the respective State Chief Procurement Official. Issues of interpretation and eligibility for participation are solely within the authority of the State Chief Procurement Official.
3. Participating Entity Modifications or Additions to Master Price Agreement:
(These modifications or additions apply only to actions and relationships within the state in which the Participating Entity is located.)

Montana Specific Terms and Conditions:

- 3.1 **ACCESS AND RETENTION OF RECORDS**: The contractor agrees to provide the department, Legislative Auditor, or their authorized agents, access to any records necessary to determine contract compliance. (Section 18-1-118, MCA) The contractor agrees to create and retain records supporting the services rendered or supplies delivered for a period of three years after either the completion date of the contract or the conclusion of any claim, litigation, or exception relating to the contract taken by the State of Montana or third party.
- 3.2 **VENUE**: This solicitation is governed by the laws of Montana. The parties agree that any litigation concerning this bid, request for proposal, limited solicitation, or subsequent contract, must be brought in the First Judicial District in and for the County of Lewis and Clark, State of Montana, and each party shall pay its own costs and attorney fees. (Section 18-1-401, MCA)
- 3.3 **REDUCTION OF FUNDING**: The State must terminate this contract if funds are not appropriated or otherwise made available to support the State's continuation of performance in a subsequent fiscal period. (See section 18-4-313(4), MCA)
- 3.4 **ASSIGNMENT, TRANSFER AND SUBCONTRACTING**: The contractor shall not assign, transfer or subcontract any portion of the contract without the express written consent of the department. (Section 18-4-141, MCA)
