This document represents an overview of the Western States Contracting Alliance Public Safety Communication Equipment. This document is not intended to replace or append the contract, rather to provide an overview and summary of the agreement.

1.0 BACKGROUND

The State of Montana is a member of the Western States Contracting Alliance (WSCA), which establishes the means by which participating states may join together in cooperative multi-state contracting in order to achieve cost-effective and efficient acquisition of quality products and services. This contract is a result of cooperative procurement conducted by the State of Washington on behalf of WSCA.

2.0 PURPOSE

The purpose of this contract is provide state agencies and all registered cooperative purchasing organizations with an expedited means of obtaining Public Safety Communication Equipment.

3.0 NON-EXCLUSIVE CONTRACT

The intent of this contract is to provide state agencies with an expedited means of procuring supplies and/or services. This contract is for the convenience of state agencies and is considered by the State Procurement Bureau to be a "Non-exclusive" use contract. Therefore, agencies may obtain this product/service from sources other than the contract holder(s) as long as they comply with Title 18, MCA, and their delegation agreement. The State Procurement Bureau does not guarantee any usage.

5.0 ORDERING PROCEDURE

In accordance with the terms of the contract, an agency purchase order must be issued to the authorized supply point for all required products. The purchase order must reference the contract number WSCA 02702 and identify all items desired, the purchase order date, the delivery date, shipping locations and prices.

6.0 CONTRACT TERM

This contract shall take effect on October 30, 2003 and terminate on October 29, 2013. (Mont. Code Ann. § 18-4-313.)

7.0 CONTRACT RENEWAL

This contract may, upon mutual agreement between the parties and according to the terms of the existing contract, be renewed in one-year intervals, or any interval that is advantageous to the State. This contract, including any renewals, may not exceed a total of five years.

1. Scope: This addendum covers the WSCA Public Safety Communications Equipment Contracts lead by the State of Washington, for members of WSCA or NASPO, for use by agencies and other entities located in the Participating Entity authorized by that state's statutes to utilize its contracts.

2. Participation: Use of specific WSCA or NASPO cooperative contracts by agencies, political subdivisions and other entities (including cooperatives) authorized by an individual state's statutes to use state contracts are subject to the approval of the respective State Chief Procurement Official. Issues of interpretation and eligibility for participation are solely within the authority of the State Chief Procurement Official.

3. Term: The term of this Participating Addendum shall be concurrent with WSCA Contract 02702 and shall renew or be extended automatically as WSCA Contract 02702 is renewed or extended. Either party may terminate this Participating Addendum for cause, in whole or in part, if the other party fails to perform in accordance with the WSCA Master Price Agreement 02702 or this Participating Addendum.

4. Participating Entity Modifications or Additions to Master Price Agreement:

State Participation: All governmental entities within the State of Montana and all registered Cooperative Purchasing Organizations are authorized to purchase products and services under the terms and conditions of the referenced Master Price Agreement. Entities are subject to all applicable state standards, policies, and procurement law, including the Montana Information Technology Act.

Reporting and Fees: Contractor shall provide the State of Montana quarterly utilization reports for all purchasing activity during same period as the MPA.

Access to Records: The Contractor shall provide the State, Legislative Auditor, or their authorized agents access to any records required to be made available by 18-1-118 MCA, in order to determine compliance with this Addendum.

Motorola complies with State audit law, including those laws protecting confidential information, proprietary information, and trade secrets. Per MCA 18-1-118, Motorola defines "records" as the contract, relevant communications with the State, and records of invoices and payments only.

Assignment, Transfer and Subcontracting: The Contractor shall not assign, transfer or subcontract any portion of this participating addendum without the express written consent of the State. (Mont. Code Ann. § 18-4-141.) The Contractor shall be responsible to the State for the acts and omissions of all subcontractors or agents and of persons directly or indirectly employed by such subcontractors, and for the acts and omissions of persons employed directly by the Contractor. No contractual relationships exist between any subcontractor and the State.

Compliance with Laws: The Contractor shall, in performance of work under this participating addendum, fully comply with all applicable federal, state, or local laws, rules, and regulations, including the Montana Human Rights Act, the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Age Discrimination Act of 1975, the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. Any subletting or subcontracting by the Contractor subjects subcontractors to the same provision. In accordance with section 49-3-207, MCA, the Contractor agrees that the hiring of persons to perform under this addendum will be made on the basis of merit and qualifications and there will be no discrimination based upon race, color, religion, creed, political ideas, sex, age, marital status, physical or mental disability, or national origin by the persons performing under this Addendum.

This contract is governed by the laws of Montana. The parties agree that any litigation concerning this bid, proposal or subsequent contract must be brought in the First Judicial District in and for the County of Lewis and Clark, State of Montana and each party shall pay its own costs and attorney fees. (See section 18-1-401, MCA.)

Technology Access for Blind or Visually Impaired: Contractor acknowledges that no state funds may be expended for the purchase of information technology equipment and software for use by employees, program participants, or members of the public unless it provides blind or visually impaired individuals with access, including interactive use of the equipment and services, that is equivalent to that provided to individuals who are not blind or visually impaired. (Section 18-5-603, MCA.).

Motorola's products are specialized public safety products and equipment intended for first responders, not standard information technology equipment and software, and are IT products, and the referenced section above is inapplicable to these products.

Purchase Approvals: All Information Technology Resources, including hardware, software, and associated services and infrastructure used to store or transmit information in any form, including voice, video, and electronic data, must be approved, as specified herein, by the Information Technology Services Division (ITSD) of the Department of Administration, except as provided in Section 2-17-516, MCA. Non-State agencies are not required to obtain this approval.

Compliance with State Plans: The Contractor is notified that pursuant to 2-17-514, MCA, the Department of Administration retains the right to cancel or modify any contract, project or activity that is not in compliance with the Agency's Plan for Information Technology, the State Strategic Plan for Information Technology, or any statewide IT policy or standard.

5. Lease Agreements: Leasing of covered equipment is authorized under this Addendum if offered by the manufacture. State agencies cannot enter a lease agreement under this Addendum without prior review and approval of said lease by the State Procurement Bureau.



